Part 6 – Non-residents

For persons living outside of the Parish of Sapcote, who wish to be buried in Sapcote cemetery, a strong connection with the village must be demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Parish Council. In the event that such a burial is approved, all fees and payments will be <u>trebled</u>, subject always to the right of the Parish Council to waive the requirement to pay treble fees at its discretion. The treble payment will not apply to persons who have left accommodation in the village to go directly to a care home or hospital because of ill health or residential care requirements.
